-  **Pilot project** with academic support. Bottom-up initiative
-  **Goal:** Developing and testing an innovative reimbursement model based on quality and value of care
 - quantity-based → quality-based payments
-  **Field:** Orthopedics (total hip & knee replacement)

partial PROMs-based add-on payment

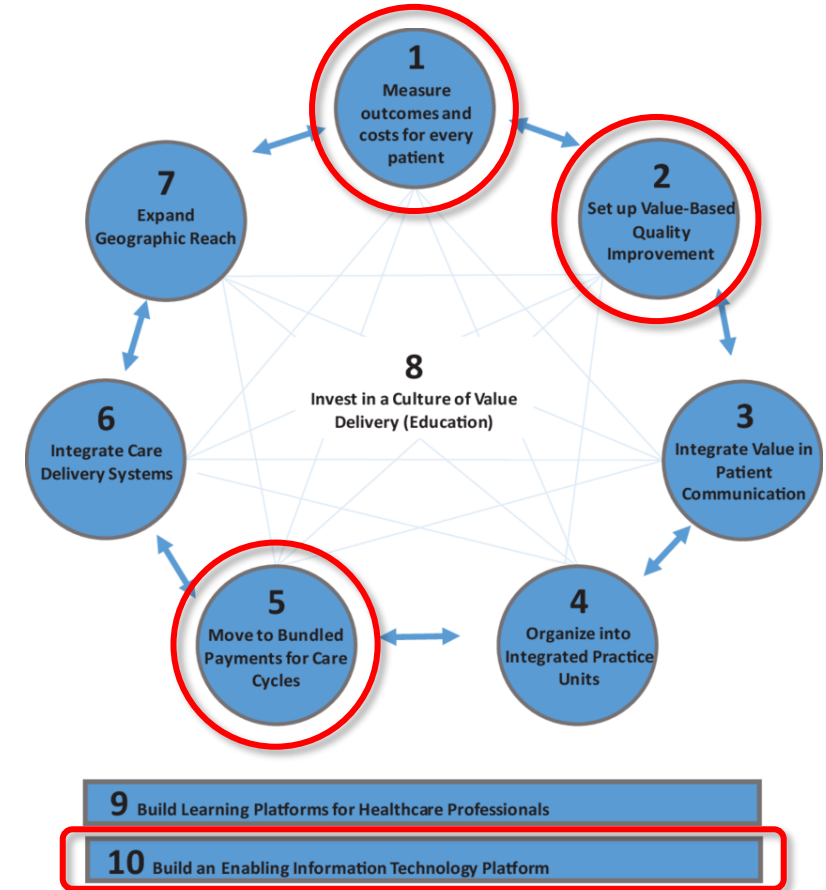


- Assessed at patient level

- Outcome: «success» / «no success» rate

- Assessed at hospital level
- Risk-adjusted model
- Clinical / routine medical data
