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What Makes These Exchanges Different?

The International Healthcare Exchange takes a different approach. Participants gain direct access to healthcare organisations, service leaders, clinicians, innovators and researchers. Through carefully curated visits and facilitated discussions, participants explore how healthcare is organised, delivered and improved in real-world settings.

This is learning through a structured professional exchange designed to generate insight, challenge assumptions and stimulate new thinking.



Our aim is not simply to show what others are doing, but to explore why particular approaches have evolved, how they are implemented, and what lessons can be applied in different contexts.

Founded by Professor Axel Kaehne, the International Healthcare Exchange builds on years of international executive education and collaboration with healthcare leaders, universities and healthcare organisations across Europe.

HOW THE EXCHANGE WORKS

Each exchange combines a carefully selected mix of activities designed to maximise practical insight and professional learning.

Organisational Visits

Visits to healthcare organisations and services, providing direct access to real-world settings and the people working within them.

Expert Discussions

Discussions with healthcare leaders, practitioners and expert briefings exploring innovative practices and service models.

Peer Learning

Facilitated conversations and professional exchange, encouraging participants to compare experiences and discuss common challenges.



What Participants Gain

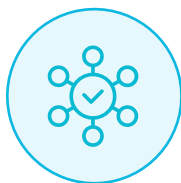

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The International Healthcare Exchange is designed to provide a flexible and accessible learning experience for busy healthcare professionals.

How It Works

- ✓ Participants arrange their own travel and accommodation, allowing flexibility to suit individual preferences, schedules and organisational travel policies.
- ✓ All educational activities, organisational visits and programme materials are organised by the Exchange team.
- ✓ Detailed joining instructions, recommended accommodation options and practical information are provided in advance.
- ✓ Dates, locations and participation fees are outlined within the individual exchange descriptions.
